Through her efforts, over 50 women have learned to create garments, earning income and gaining confidence. Samia says, “Helping others become self-reliant is the greatest reward.”



Successful Project spotlight

The Growing Hope permaculture training project in Kabazana, Ruhoko, Misiera, and Kityaza Villages has been a major success. It has trained 180 participants in sustainable farming techniques, helping them increase crop yields while preserving the environment. Beneficiaries have expressed gratitude for the knowledge, which not only improves food security but also fosters community integration.

As the holiday season approaches, Nakivale’s diverse community is preparing to celebrate festivals like Christmas and New Year’s Eve.
